- The CPRB is dedicated to ensuring that Oakland has a professional police department whose members behave with integrity and justice.
- The CPRB investigates and reviews complaints about Oakland police officer conduct.
- The board strives to improve police services for *all* citizens of Oakland, regardless of socio-economic status, race, ethnicity, or citizenship status.

- A City of Oakland survey indicated that the vast majority of negative interactions with the Oakland Police Department are never formally reported.
- Learn about the CPRB and how they can help you. It is your right as an Oakland citizen to ensure that your voice is heard!
